Elections are being held for the position of Police and Crime Commissioner on **Thursday**, **2**nd **May 2024**.

Our local polling station in **Tingewick Village Hall** which will be open for voting from **7am to 10pm**.

This will be our first election under the new Voter ID rules so I thought I'd refresh your memory of what acceptable ID is, what you can do if you don't have accepted ID and other ways to vote if you can't vote in person.

What is a Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC)?

A Police and Crime Commissioner (PCC) is an elected official in England and Wales responsible for overseeing the local police. They act as a bridge between the public and the police, making sure the police are accountable to the communities they serve. Here's a breakdown of their key duties:

- Leadership and vision: PCCs set the strategic direction for the police force through a Police and Crime Plan, outlining priorities for tackling crime and keeping communities safe.
- **Resource management:** They control the police budget, allocating funds and determining the amount people pay towards policing through their council tax.
- **Appointment and oversight:** PCCs appoint the Chief Constable, the most senior police officer in the force. They hold the Chief Constable accountable for the force's performance and can dismiss them if necessary.
- **Community voice:** PCCs act as a voice for the public, ensuring local concerns and priorities are reflected in policing strategies. They engage with communities and encourage public participation.

In essence, PCCs aim to bridge the gap between the police and the people, ensuring an effective and efficient police service that meets the needs of the local community.

What Are Accepted Forms Of Voter ID?

Here are some of the accepted forms of ID to enable you to cast your vote. Please see the full list on the <u>Electoral Commission Website</u>. Photo ID can be out of date as long as the picture still looks like you.

- UK Passport
- UK Drivers Licence (including Provisional)
- Older Person's Bus Pass (Note: Student Travel Cards/Rail Cards are NOT valid ID)
- Disabled Person's Bus Pass
- Freedom Pass
- Voter Authority Certificate (See below)
- PASS Card (with hologram)
- EEA National Identity Card

How To Register To Vote

If you have recently turned 18 or are not currently on the electoral register you will need to register to be eligible to vote.

You will need to register by **Tuesday 16th April**.

You'll need your National Insurance Number (you can register without it but they'll need to run extra checks). Check out the <u>Register To Vote</u> page on the Gov.UK site to begin the process.

How To Check You're On The Voter Register

If you have recently moved, changed name or are not sure you are on the electoral register you can check the information held by contacting the local registration office. You <u>can find your office here</u> in order to contact them to check and amend your information.



Other Ways To Vote

If you can't (or don't want to) vote in person you can apply to vote by mail or request a proxy vote.

You'll need to apply by **5pm on 17 April 2024** to get a postal vote for the 2 May 2024 elections. You can find <u>more information about postal votes and how to apply here</u>.

A proxy vote allows you to nominate somebody else who will vote in person on your behalf. Unlike a postal vote, you have to provide a reason for using a proxy to cast your vote. You'll need to apply by **5pm on 24 April 2024** to vote by proxy in the 2 May 2024 elections. You can find more information about voting by proxy, and <u>what information you need to provide here</u>.

How To Apply For A Voter Authority Certificate

If you do not have a valid form of ID, or do not wish to show this ID at the polling station you can apply for a Voter Authority certificate.

This is a piece of paper with your Name, issuing authority, certificate number and issue/renew dates on it.

Once you are registered to vote, the Voter Authority Certificate can be obtained free of charge by supplying your National Insurance Number and a passport sized photo.

You will need to apply for a Voter Authority Certificate by **5pm on Wednesday 24 April**.

BUILDING WORK AT THE RECREATION GROUND

This is to let you all know that, after a longer than anticipated wait, the works on upgrading the sports pavilion at the recreation ground are finally due to start on Monday 18th March.

While these building works are taking place, we do ask that all visitors to the rec take extra care and respect the fenced off and restricted areas while the build is in progress. CCTV cameras will be in use at all times.

This work will take approximately 3 months to complete and will include a smart new layout, including toilets and showers for home and away teams, an officials changing area, entrance lobby and new veranda.

Tingewick Football Club are the main users at this time and have for too long put up with old and tired changing facilities for their matches. So we are more than pleased for them to have this new facility.

This new pavilion is something the village can be proud of and will hopefully attract more sport teams to use the recreation space throughout the year...perhaps a village cricket team could be formed...anyone interested ??
