### GENERAL ELECTION: POLLS OPEN 7AM on the 4<sup>th</sup> OF JULY

On Thursday the 4<sup>th</sup> our local polling station – Tingewick Village Hall – will be **open from 7am to 10pm** for you to cast your vote in the General Election.

Don't forget that you will now need to bring voter ID with you in order to be able to cast your vote. Click on this page to go to the full list of accepted ID, but briefly they are:

- A Voter Authority Certificate
- A UK Passport
- A UK Provisional or Full Driving Licence
- Blue Badge
- Older Person's Bus Pass
- Disabled Person's Buss Pass
- Freedom Pass
- ID Card that has the PASS Hologram
- Biometric Residence Permit
- National Identity Card

Not that it will happen here (I think!) but if you are in line before the 10pm cut-off time you are still eligible to cast your vote.

If you registered for a postal vote and haven't received it, you can go to your local election office to have the ballot reissued or apply for an emergency proxy vote up to 5pm on election day. If you have a postal ballot and forgot to send it off in time this can be handed in at the polling station.






