

Editor's Comment:

Supermarket Vouchers

There are a lot of scams online at the moment that tell you you're eligible to win vouchers for differing supermarket chains just by filling in a form. Watch out though, if you enter these competitions you will then start to receive unsolicited text messages which can be charged at several pounds a time. Remember, most major supermarkets won't use social media to run promotions of this type and, as always, if it sounds to good to be true it probably is.

Bank Scams

Another scam that's caught quite a few people out recently is that you'll receive a phone call purporting to be from your bank – and if you're on your mobile the caller ID will look like it's from their registered number. They'll sound very convincing and have details of some of your account activity and unlike other scams they won't ask for any identifying information but they'll tell you your account has been compromised and ask you to move your money to a "safe" account which they'll give you the details for.

If your bank is worried about the safety of your money, they will simply block transactions on your account, they'll never ask you to move money elsewhere. As long as you report a lost/stolen card or fraudulent activity on your account within your bank's timeframe (usually within 24 hours but do check to be sure) you will be covered. The problem with this scam is that as you will have been seen to have moved your money willingly so it's difficult to claim anything back under fraud rules.

If you're unsure, hang up the phone and call your bank from another line using the number from your statement or the back of your bank card, NEVER take anything at face value no matter how genuine it seems.

Cllr Lightfoot – Street Lighting

The light reported on Buckingham Street at the last meeting has been repaired. A light in Gorrell Close has been reported and is scheduled for repair next week.

Cllr Lightfoot expressed thanks to Cllr Fenemore, Cllr Hornsey and Cllr Maxwell for organising the Christmas Tree and lights.

Cllr Hornsey – Playgrounds, Footways and Street Furniture

Cllr Maxwell advised there is one area in the school playground where the wet-pour surface is weakened, it is believed to be from a sunken tree root. Cllr Hornsey to check the area and consult BCC regarding responsibility for the area as the PC do lease the area from them for the play equipment but the Lease for that does not cover anything about the ground foundations.

Cllr Swinburne - Cemetery, Grass Cutting and Special Projects
