I am sure by now that you are all aware of the horrible events that occurred on the night of Sunday 26th of September where Tingewick Pre-School and the Tingewick Roundwood School site were callously targeted by suspected arsonists.

The staff, governors and pupils are obviously deeply upset by this, especially considering that they were just returning to some sense of normalcy after the events of the past 18 months.

While the true extent of the damage isn't known at the time of writing this, there will undoubtedly be a lot of equipment that needs to be replaced thanks to the fire, smoke and water associated with the blaze and extinguishing it.

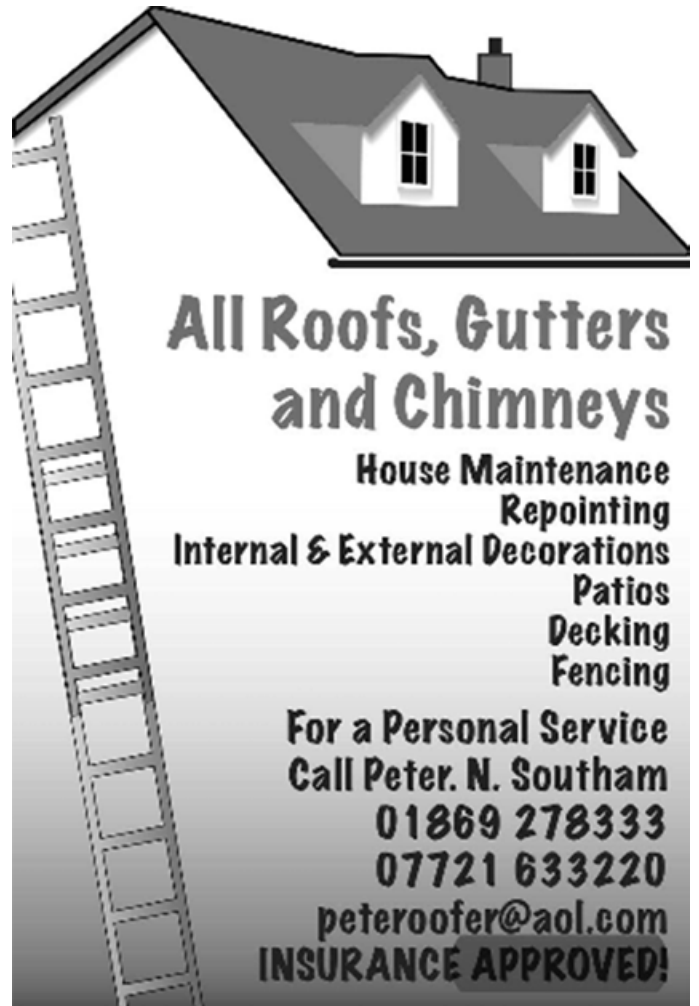

PARISH MEETING AGM

This was held on Friday 10th September at 7pm in The Old School. We were privileged to have our M.P., and two Councillors present, each of whom gave an interesting report on the work of his area of government. This was followed by our Chairman's report, which covered two years, as last year's meeting was postponed because of the pandemic. Other members of the committee then reported on their areas of responsibility.

It was impressive how much has been done despite the restrictions imposed by Covid. Seven planning applications have been considered, social events organized, The Old School deep-cleaned and a garden waste bin and water heater provided there, grass mown, railings painted, daffodils planted, missing kerb stones reported, a dog waste bin ordered, 30mph stickers distributed and pressure put on the authorities about accidents at the crossroads. There was an excellent response to the request for help during the pandemic. There are plans for a Christmas party, Covid permitting, and early discussions about celebrating the Queen's Platinum Jubilee. It was noted that fibre has now been laid through the village.

The meeting discussed proposed measures, which had been circulated in advance, to reduce the speed of traffic through the village. It was agreed that, if a grant for this is obtained, a further meeting will be needed. HS2 traffic has been photographed and reported with good results, so this is to be encouraged.

All members of the committee were re-elected: Susan, Brian, Martin, Rob, Dawn and Rachel. We thank them for the considerable amount of time each has spent looking after our interests, under Susan's leadership. Martin is stepping down as Clerk, a role he has fulfilled with conscientious efficiency.
