#### **Church Opening**


The Church is now closed during the day apart from for services. We will re-open daily again in the Spring.



## Do you need to have a good sort-out?

Have you tuned in to Stacey Solomon's BBC One programme "Sort Your Life Out"? If you haven't seen the show, Stacey helps people that have become overwhelmed with 'things' - possessions which have built up over time and become prohibitive to a functional daily life.

At some point, we've probably all been faced with a drawer, cupboard or room full of items that we don't know what to do with - and quickly closed the door again. It can be hard to part with things. There's a completely natural and common feeling of 'but what if I need this one day?' or there may be a sentimental reason for holding on to it. Often we simply don't have the time (or inclination) to deal with the issue. However, the benefits of reorganising and decluttering can be significant.

<u>What are the benefits?</u> Less things in your life means less to tidy, less to clean and less to think about. Less items create the feeling of space and room to breathe in your home. You can also locate items when needed, with greater speed and ease.

Keeping items in a tidy and organised manner results in a feeling of increased control over your life, which leads to a greater sense of wellbeing and more time to spend doing things you really enjoy. It can also help the planet as many items that you no longer need can be recycled, donated to charity or sold, and therefore put to good use. You don't have to let go of everything but to go through the process of assessing what you have, and what you want to keep, and reorganising it can be very beneficial.

**How do you start to organise your home?** Starting small is always advised – pick one drawer. Remove the items. What don't you want to put back in the drawer? What should go somewhere else? Aside from TV shows, there is endless advice available on the internet and there are various books on the subject that have been published over the years.

If you'd like more hands-on assistance you could engage a Professional Organiser and Declutterer. They are able to assist with anything from reorganising spaces, to preparing for whole house moves. They can help organise paperwork or photos that may have built up over the years - or even with managing the clearance of a home in the sad event of a bereavement. Having someone who will work at your pace and guide you through the process with understanding can be extremely helpful, and their experience invaluable.

With the colder weather now here and the festive season almost upon us, our homes are the backdrop for entertaining friends and family or perhaps just a quiet and cosy place to relax. However you use your home, being able to enjoy it to its maximum potential is the goal.
