REMINDER: VOTING CHANGES IN 2023 Photo ID needed from May 2023 at Polling Stations

As part of recent changes to the law you will need to show photographic identification at the polling station before you can be issued with your ballot papers.

The voting process remains the same – all you need to remember is a form of accepted photo ID. You will only need to show one form of photo ID, but it must be the original and not a photocopy.

There are various forms of acceptable ID that include (but aren't limited to)

- Photo Driving Licence
- Passport
- Proof of Age (PASS) card
- EEA State ID
- Certain bus passes/travel card (mainly over 60s)
- Blue badge

Voting by mail is not affected, but if you choose to use a proxy vote then the person voting on your behalf must have an accepted form of ID with them.

If you do not have ID that will be accepted, you can apply for a "Voter Authority Certficiate". You will need a recent digital photo of yourself and your National Insurance number (or other documents if you don't have this to hand). You can apply for this at



Pond News

Just to announce that we are fundraising to refurbish Townsend Pond in our village. In the summer of 2022 it became very evident that the pond was badly silted up.



To date we have received donations to the value of \pounds 825 for which we wish to convey our thanks, however we still have a mountain to climb as this will cost thousands of pounds alone, our initial target is to raise £15,000. It has become clear in obtaining quotes however that the pond liner also needs replacing and to keep the water quality healthy going forward we also need to plant the pond.

We have a long way to go and this is going to take some time, many of us though feel that the pond is a real visual and environmental asset to our village and we would love it to be a real wildlife haven for all to visit and enjoy. We do not want Townsend Pond to fade away

Why You Should Not Feed Ducks

The Problems with feeding ducks

Feeding ducks can lead to the following problems

• Overcrowding – where food is easy to come by, ducks and other waterfowl will lay more eggs and



the pond will become overcrowded. This makes it more difficult for the birds to seek out healthier food sources and increases territorial aggression, especially during mating season. It will cause ducks to cross busy streets in search of food.

- Pollution What happens to all the food that is not eaten? It causes algae growth, pollution, and can eventually eradicate fish and other life in the vicinity.
- Diseases A diet rich in carbohydrates leads to greater faecal production and bird faeces easily harbour bacteria responsible for numerous diseases including avian botulism.
- Attraction of pests Rotting leftover food attracts other unwelcome pests such a rats, mice and insects. These pests can also harbour additional diseases that can be dangerous to humans.



Whilst our aim is to educate and inform as we cannot prohibit people from feeding the ducks if they wish, but please only feed as much as they will immediately eat as leaving food does not create a pleasant environment for others to visit and enjoy.


