



Memories Of Tingewick Pond

Reading the article in January's 2023 Tingewick News regarding the formation of the action group to bring the Tingewick Pond back to an established healthy pond, brings back pleasant memories.

My name is Ron Clark. I lived on Main Street for 10 years, leaving in 2000, and during that time, I was Chairman of the Parish Council for 8 years.

In the early 1990's a gentleman named John Farrell, who also lived on Main Street, led a team of willing helpers, namely, Dave Jeffkins, Barry Jones and Jim Green to sort out the dormant pond at the west end of the Main Street known as "Townsend Pond." A plan was devised to use a vermiculite based compound manufactured in Milton Keynes and to pummel it into the hollow where the pond used to be, using an army of people in wellies and a herd of cows loaned by a local farmer. This would form a layer at the base of the hollow that would retain water, thus forming a pond.

The first task was to raise funds for the compound mixture. This started the "First Sponsored Tingewick Piano Smash." The rules were quite basic without much concern to method statements or health and safety. Within the confines of the Crown car park a group of able willing men using sledge hammers, crow bars and saws would smash up a complete working piano. (We knew it worked because John played it before the action started.) The bits of the piano then had then to be passed through a letter box, even the dust had to go through, before the piano was declared completely broken. The time this took was closely monitored, the time was then used for the sponsorship winner to be declared.

As you can imagine there were cuts and bruises, but a good time was had by all and a considerable amount of ale was drunk.

Whilst a good sum of money was raised it was not enough for all purchases to be made. After much thought the "Second Sponsored Tingewick Piano Smash" was conceived. This was based on the same rules as the first piano smash, but with a twist! Ladies would challenge Men. A handicap was conceived that being that the men would have to pick up their piano from the Royal Oak car park and get it to the Crown car park, but the ladies could start their smash in the Crown car park at the same time the men picked up their piano from the Royal Oak car park.

A lot of planning was required since the bypass was not in place at that time, but true to Tingewick tradition a good time was had by all.

However, when the work was completed, the pond still did not hold water completely, so it was decided to wait and see what the elements would do over a few months. Coincidently communication was received by the Parish Council from a landscaping company that wished to establish itself in Buckinghamshire.

Consultations began with Buckinghamshire County Council, people of the village and this landscaping company. The end result was that the landscaping company would line our pond for free, Buckinghamshire County Council would monitor the progress and if successful would add the landscaping company to their list of landscaping suppliers bidding for future projects.

The work commenced and with the rescheduled training area one weekend for Buckingham Fire Brigade the pond again began its life to this day, some 30 years later.




